	The organization is led by an Executive Director/CEO of color. (No = 0 points/Yes = 10 points)
	The application demonstrates potential vendors, consultants, and/or products for the project have been thoroughly researched and identified. (10 points)
	This grant can provide leverage to attract donors or serve as final element to fully fund the project. (10 points)
	The project can clearly have a positive impact on the organization's core internal operations and how effectively the organization can fulfill its mission. (25 points)
	The project budget is clear, detailed, and reasonable. (20 points)
